







APPENDIX 3 INTERVIEW RESULT

1. Mr. Aristama as The Secretary of Pahawang Island Interview Result:

- The peak of Pahawang Island tourism was from 2016 to 2018 and decreased after the Covid-19 era. And it's been increasing lately but not as much as usual.
- Increasing community empowerment started with the existence of a very honorable person named Mr. Ju. He was the one who started conservation education by relying on community participation from child to adult.
- The main livelihoods of Pahawang Island are tourism, fisheries, and agriculture.
- There are 4 types of sea urchins owned by Pahawang Island and they are most likely to increase economic growth.
- Conservation activities on Pahawang Island are mangrove nurseries, planting coral reefs, and beach cleaning.
- Other uniqueness of Pahawang Island such as cultural tourism, community tourism, mountain peaks (napak tilas), and mangroves forest of 1020 ha.

2. Mrs. Badrinah as Local Resident

• The most influential tourist on the island of Pahawang is Mr. Ju. He founded schools and the community can be educated in environmental conservation and community empowerment.
