This study aims to determine the effect of Entrepreneurship Education, Perceived Behavioral Control, Inspiring Role Models, and Attitude towards Entrepreneurship on Entrepreneurial Intentions of Entrepreneurship Students at Agung Podomoro University. By using quantitative research methods and carried out on 93 students majoring in Entrepreneurship at Agung Podomoro University. The results of this study indicate that Attitude towards Entrepreneurship and Inspiring Role Models are factors that have a significant influence on entrepreneurial intentions. This research is expected to be able to specifically assist Agung Podomoro University Entrepreneurship in improving the quality of learning and producing more entrepreneurial graduates.
